



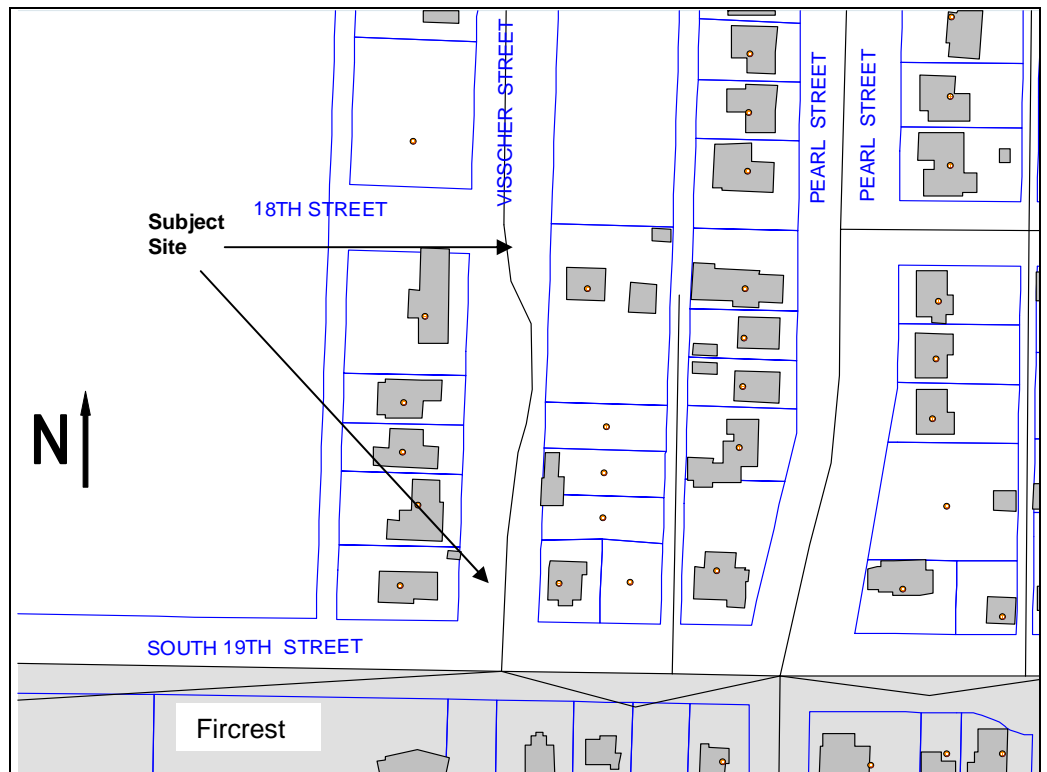

Applicant City of Tacoma, c/o Ken Lee, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, WA 98402

Proposal Wetland Assessment Permit to allow construction of road improvements on South Visscher Street between South 18th and South 19th Streets. The existing gravel/dirt road will be improved with a new asphalt/concrete road surface, concrete curb and gutter, sidewalks, driveway approaches, storm sewer improvements and sanitary sewer connections. A Wetland and Drainage Corridor Assessment conducted by Habitat Technologies indicates that a Type II and a Type III wetland are located within 300 feet of the subject improvements; however, the associated 100 foot and 75 foot respective wetland buffers required under the 2005 Critical Areas Preservation Ordinance do not extend onto the project site. Therefore, no impact to the wetlands or their associated buffers is proposed. The subject site is located within the "R-2" One-Family Dwelling District.
